Pre-Authorized Electronic Assessment Payment Service

CIT Bank (a division of First Citizens Bank) gives us the opportunity to have a full service on-line presence. That means Villa Antigua Homeowners Association now can offer Members an opportunity to pay their regular, monthly association assessments using *automated electronic payments* (ACH), without the inconvenience of writing a check.

The Pre-authorized Assessment Payment Service uses the Federal Reserve System's Automated Clearing House (ACH) to facilitate electronic transfers from Homeowner checking accounts directly into the association's bank account. **Funds will be transferred between the 5th and 10th day of the month**. Information regarding payments will be reported to the association's management on the same day funds are deposited to the association's account.

Pre-authorized automatic payments should help homeowner's **eliminate late payments and the need to write and send checks through the mail.** In addition, the association is assured prompt, predictable payments to help better manage its funds. **The program is available to all homeowners regardless of where they bank.**

To Enroll in the Pre-authorized Assessment Payment Service:

I. Read, complete, and sign the Authorization form.

2. Attach a voided check where indicated on the form and mail to, or drop it off at, the Association office.
